

Getting Started

1. Download the **Cubase MIDI Mapping** file from the MIDImix product page at Akai Pro.com and unzip the folder.
2. Place the **MIDImix_Cubase.xml** file and **MIDImix_CubasePreset** file in a location where it can be found easily, like a Documents folder or Desktop.

Loading the MIDImix Cubase Preset with the MIDImix Editor

1. Download and install the **MIDImix Editor** from the MIDImix product page at Akai Pro.com
2. Connect your MIDImix to a USB port on your computer
3. Close all other Audio/MIDI software, including Cubase, and launch the editor
4. From the top left of the Editor window, select **File > Open Preset**
5. In the window that opens, locate and choose the **MIDImix_CubasePreset** file you saved in Step 2 above. A new editor window will appear.
6. In the new window, select **File > Send to Hardware**
7. Your MIDImix should now be ready to map to Cubase

Installing the MIDImix Cubase Remote File

1. Launch Cubase.
2. From the top of the Cubase window, select **Devices > Device Setup**.
3. In the Device Setup window, click on the + in the top left corner and choose **Generic Remote** from the list.
4. Set the input and output options to **MIDI Mix**.
5. Click **Import**, in the window that opens locate and choose the **MIDImix_Cubase.xml** file you saved in Step 2 above.
6. Click **Open** to load the mapping file.
7. Click **Apply** and **OK**
