

MPC Sample 1.2.0 Release Notes

Added

- **SD Card Access**
 - In the Project Page, enter SD Card Access to transfer files between your computer and SD card.
- **Export Song to Sequence**
 - While in Song Mode, pressing Export will allow you to choose between exporting as audio or a new sequence. Allowing creation of automation across the project and performing FX over your arrangement.
 - If the new sequence is longer than 128 bars, you will not be able to edit the length of the created sequence.
- **Loop Lock per Pad**
 - While in SAMPLE > TRIM holding SHIFT and tapping Loop Lock (B1) will lock the loop start to the sample start position. Ideal for percussion loops.
 - This setting is per pad, different pads can have different loop lock states.

Changes

- Improvements to Saving and Loading.
- Improvements to disk streaming voice management.
- Improvements to auto-save.

Fixed

- Crash when zooming on long samples in Chop Mode.
- Window doesn't shift to markers when moving between lazy chop slices.
- Waveform zoom is not retained when adjusting Start/End knobs in Chop.
- Sample previews do not play over USB audio.
- + Many more!

Known Issues

- Audio glitches in Flex Beat while changing tempo.
 - Set Flex Beat to 100% Dry to prevent glitches.
